

Code of Conduct for Players

For all club members:

- Represent your club in a positive manner;
- Come for training or matches 'basketball ready' and on time;
- Be inclusive of new players whatever their background or ability;
- Never bully, spread rumours or tell lies about other people;
- Control your emotions verbal or physical abuse is not acceptable at any time;
- Support teammates who make mistakes;
- Treat everyone equally and do not discriminate on any level;
- Treat your team-mates and opponents, coaches, volunteers, club officials and match officials with respect at all times;
- Do not use offensive language or gestures at any time;
- Abide by the rules and avoid rough play to maintain the spirit of the game;
- Give maximum effort, energy and enthusiasm to strive for your best possible performance throughout the whole session;
- Work equally hard for yourself and your team;

For team members:

- Train and play for Piranhas only. Once in one of our DBA teams,
 players may only train at Piranhas and no other DBA club, even for
 casual training sessions, due to conflicts of interest at the Local
 League level;
- Accept the decisions of the match officials without question or complaint and avoid misleading a match official;
- Focus on the game and your team's performance. Raise any concerns to your coach or the match officials;
- Thank your opponents and the match officials at the end of play;
- Learn to accept victory and defeat with humility and dignity and without excessive emotional displays;
